

# Show Date & Recital Tickets

**ALL TICKETS MUST BE PURCHASED FROM THE ANNENBERG THEATRE. PLEASE FOLLOW MONTHLY NEWSLETTERS FOR UPCOMING INFORMATION.**

**TICKETS MUST BE PURCHASED BEFORE ANY COSTUMES CAN BE PICKED UP.**

- Each same sibling household must purchase a minimum of 7 tickets.
- In the event there are two shows, students performing in both shows must purchase 7 tickets to their primary level performance.
- Tickets are limited to shows where students may make guest appearances.
- Families with only 1 dancer in one performance must purchase a minimum of 7 tickets for that performance before purchasing tickets to another performance.
- You can purchase more tickets once your minimum 7 are purchased.
- The only way the 7 tickets can be split is if you have same household siblings in lower school and upper school.
- ALL 7 TICKETS MUST BE PURCHASED AT THE SAME TIME AND CASH ONLY.
- You will be notified via newsletter of set date of the recital.
- Tentative recital date is June 2010.

### UNIFORM AND SHOES

#### Girls:

- Leotards-Black Long Sleeve
- Leotards can only be nylon or cotton and lycra blend.
- Tights – Suntan Transitional (Non-Shimmer and no footless tights)

#### Boys:

- Black sweat pants and a white t-shirt

#### Adults:

- Comfortable Clothing

#### Shoes:

- *Ballet* – Pink or Tan Canvas or Leather Slippers
- *Tap* (Boys) Black Capezio Tapster • *Tap* (Girls) – Suntan Buckle Tap Shoe
- *Jazz* – Tan Jazz slip-ons • *Acrobatics* – White Athenians
- *Hip Hop* – Black Hip Hop Sneakers • *African, Praise and Modern* students need bare feet • *Pointe*-Pink pointe shoes. You may have to buy more than 1 pair a year.
- Skirt attachments, ruffles, logs or puff sleeves on leotards and footless tights are not permitted.
- The studio reserves the right to refuse students from class if they are not in proper uniform.

## REGISTRATION FEES

Returning Students (Completed 1 Year) - \$40.00  
New Students - \$50.00

## TUITION INFORMATION

Tuition will be due 1 month in advance.  
(Per Student Per Month)

- 1 Class - \$50
- 2 Classes - \$75
- 3 Classes - \$100
- 4 Classes - \$125
- 5 Classes - \$150
- 6 Classes to Unlimited Classes - \$175 per month
- Adult Classes - \$60 for 6 weeks of class. Full payment is required before the start of class.



- There is a 3% Discount for yearly prepaid tuition.
- The studio reserves the right to dismiss student for any untimely payment of all fees and tuition.

2t - Large Adult - First Costume \$80  
each additional \$70  
Size Extra Large Adult - First Costume \$100  
each additional \$80  
Size Extra-Extra Large Adult and up - First costume \$120  
each additional \$90

# Payments

**The Pointe!** is a full 10 month program that runs September-June. If your child is absent or misses time away from the program, tuition is still due.

- Tuition can be paid monthly or bi-weekly basis. Check, Money Orders, Debit or Credit
- Costume payments are added in with tuition from the months of September thru January.
- In February tuition payments will drop down to tuition payments only.
- Monthly Payments: Must be received by the 1st of the month (\$20 late fee after the 5th)
- Bi-Weekly Payments: 1st half due by the 1st of the month (\$20 late fee after the 5th) and 2nd half due by the 15th (\$20 late fee after the 15th)
- Payments can be made during posted office hours, mailed or dropped in the payment drop box.
- Administration is not responsible for missing change or receipts if a child is sent to the office to make payments.
- Please include student's name in memo line when writing checks or money orders.
- There is a \$30 returned check fee. If a check is returned, check writing privileges will be lost.
- All fees are subject to change without prior notice.
- **ALL FEES MUST BE PAID BEFORE STUDENT WILL BE PERMITTED TO PARTICIPATE IN ANY MASS REHEARSALS AND RECITALS. THIS INCLUDES PURCHASE OF TICKETS. TICKETS MUST BE PURCHASED BEFORE ANY COSTUMES CAN BE PICKED UP.**
- If a class is dropped the costume fee is non-refundable and non-transferable.
- The account holder will still be responsible for all costumes for any classes dropped after 10/31.
- Costumes will not be released to any parent unless all fees for student are paid in full.
- **The Pointe!** cannot guarantee on-time arrival of costumes if ANY costume payments have not been paid on time.
- **The Pointe!** is likewise not responsible for late arrival of costumes due to distributor delays.
- If a costume has to be exchanged for a larger size you will be billed for the difference.
- Parents are responsible for purchasing all accessories for the annual recital, and all necessary spray painting of shoes or other accessories.

# Hair & Attendance

## HAIR

- No barrettes, beads or scarves may be worn during class.
- For recital ALL students must have their hair un-braided and pulled back in a low bun with no hair ornaments in it at all.

On the show date, if the student does not have un-braided hair pulled back in a low bun they will not be allowed to perform.

This is keeping with proper dance etiquette.

## ATTENDANCE

**(Attendance is very important)**

- If a student is going to be absent, please call the studio in advance.
- Each student is allowed to have 5 excused absences per year. Excused absences include: weddings, funerals, graduations and illness.
- Each student is allowed to have 5 unexcused absences. An unexcused absence is when a parent does not call to report the absence.
- 5 unexcused absences will result in the student being dropped from the roll.
- Promptness when dropping off and picking up a student is essential.
- Students may not be dropped off more than 5 minutes before their class begins.
- Students picked up late or dropped off early will have a \$1 per minute fee accessed to their account.
- Students having more than 1 hour between classes must leave the building after their class and return at the start of the next class time.
- 10/31 is the last day to add/drop classes.
- A written notice must be given to add or drop classes. The account holder will still be responsible for all costumes for any classes dropped after 10/31.
